Sermon Notes

- I. What About the Old Testaments? Romans 11:1-6, 29-36
 - A. Universalism versus the rejection of Israel.
 - 1. The rejection of Gentiles versus the rejection of Jews.
 - a. More Jews, at this point, had responded to the gospel than Gentiles (Romans and Greeks).
 - B. Verse 26 "all Israel will be saved."
 - 1. This is a recurring expression in Jewish literature of the time that refers to the remnant of the faithful representing Israel as a whole, but not every individual.
 - 2. Jewish teachers always followed this statement with a list of those Israelites who would not be saved.
 - C. "It ain't over till it's over!" (verses 29-36)
 - 1. God is the one, in Christ, who judges. His calling and his judgment is inscrutable and irrevocable.
 - 2. Because we have received mercy, we should constantly be looking for and encouraging others to look for opportunities to extend the mercy we have received to those living in "disobedience" (vv. 30-32).
