SERMON NOTES

I. Foiled Again!

Matthew 22:15-22

- A. An ongoing confrontation.
 - Verse 15 The Pharisees "plotted how to entangle him in his words" (NIV – "laid plans to trap him"). This was not a casual or serendipitous response to Jesus' teaching, but a systematic effort to discredit him and eliminate him.
 - 2. Having failed before in direct confrontation, they send their disciples and the Herodians, hoping that this will confuse Jesus.
 - a. Herodians would have been loyal to the Roman Empire and very supportive of the tax.
 - b. The Pharisees and their disciples objected to the tax because it had to be paid with the denarius which bore the image of the emperor and declared him "son of God".
 - c. Verse 18 "You hypocrites" despite their official position, they produce a denarius on demand.
- B. The question: Is it lawful to pay taxes to the emperor?
 - 1. They precede the question with a seemingly flattering statement about Jesus' ministry (v. 16). It's a setup!
 - a. They don't really want an answer. They want Jesus to either defy the Law of God or the law of the Herodians and the Empire.
 - 2. Jesus' answer not only confounds their efforts to entrap him, but gives all believers a mandate for appropriate stewardship to both the world

(including the government) and the kingdom of God (see Malachi 1:8).

C. The response.

- 1. Verse 22 "They (the followers of the Pharisees and the Herodians) marveled."
- 2. Their amazement, however, does not lead to belief. They just retreat (probably as quickly as they could get out of there!).
- 3. Both the Sadducees and the Pharisees will each try to entrap him one more time.
