Sermon Notes

I. Beautiful Feet

Romans 10:5-15

A. Verses 5-8. Righteousness based on the law (old covenant) and righteousness based on faith (new covenant).

1. Paul is still addressing the salvation of Israel here, but the divide to which he refers applies to all who would seek to be right with God.
2. As a former Pharisee, Paul knew what it meant to believe that allegiance to the law could bring the Messiah. It was the Pharisaic hope that if the Israelites could become “perfect according to the law”, the “Christ” would come.
 - a. Despite the fact that they were often well intentioned, they were, nevertheless, tragically off the mark. And Paul’s heart breaks for them.

B. Verses 8-13. But the righteousness that is based on faith is a matter of the heart that is brought about by God’s redemptive work, not ours, which we acknowledge by our confession of faith in Jesus as our Lord and the Lord.

1. Therefore, “if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved” (vv. 9-10).
 - a. This is not a formula, but a summary of what has happened in our salvation.
 - b. “Jesus is Lord” was the earliest creed (often used at baptism and in times of persecution).
 - c. It is Jesus’ resurrection that confirms his Lordship. “If Christ has not been raised, then our proclamation has been in vain and your faith has been in vain” (I Corinthians 15:14).

C. The dignity and importance of the evangelistic mission (verses 14-15).

1. Paul refers to Isaiah’s poetic and prophetic words in Isaiah 52:7 to reinforce the urgency of our mission.
2. The questions.
 - a. How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed?
 - b. How are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard?
 - c. How are they to hear without someone preaching?
 - d. How are they to preach unless they are sent?
3. The answer.
 - a. “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach good news!”
