Sermon Notes

I. Now, Here's A Tongue Twister!

Romans 7:15-25a

- A. Paul's language in this text reflects the same kind of struggle that is evident in our battle against sin.
 - 1. He mixes metaphors and changes terminology, but we all know what he's talking about.
 - 2. A list of various terms.
 - a. <u>"I"</u> The interior Christian life and commitment (vv. 15-17, 22) . . . that which wants to do good and hates evil (v. 21).
 - b. Synonymous with <u>"I"</u> is the expression <u>"my</u> inner being" in verse 22.
 - c. <u>"mind"</u> (v. 23) similar to <u>"I"</u> and <u>"my inner being"</u> The sense of God and conscience that Paul teaches in Romans 1:19-20, 2:14-16.
 - d. <u>"law"</u> (vv. 21-23) signifies both the perfect law of Moses and its "evil double" which "bears the same name", but "is the work of sin" v. 23 (C.K. Barrett).
 - e. <u>"sin that dwells within me"</u>, <u>"flesh"</u>, <u>"members"</u> – The proclivity toward sin which is the condition of all human beings.
- B. Paul speaks of himself in the present tense in this text.
 - 1. He is not referring to the time before his salvation. He didn't struggle with sin and law then, but, instead, as a Pharisee, considered himself perfect according to the law.
 - 2. He is not referring to a time before his sanctification or a second blessing.
 - 3. He is referring to the ongoing battle and journey of growing in Christ in a world full of sin.

C. Paul's hope is sure (v. 25)!

- Despite the agony of his struggle, he concludes with gratitude and even, celebration, proclaiming, "Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord!"
- 2. His hope is not centered primarily on his capability, but on Christ (see Philippians 1:6 "I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ").
