#### Sermon Notes

I. Don't let your forgiver get broken! Matthew 18:21-35

- A. How many times?
  - 1. Amos 1:9, 11, 13 ff. "For three sins, even for four, I will not turn back my wrath."
  - 2. Rabbinic law 3 strikes and your out.
  - 3. Peter is being generous when he suggests seven times.
  - 4. Verse 22 77 times is intended as hyperbole. Keep forgiving!
- B. The Parable
  - 1. Ten thousand talents.
    - a. V. 24 1 talent is equal to 15 years' wages.
    - b. V. 28 100 denarii is equal to 100 days' wages.
  - 2. Our sinfulness causes us to instinctively resent forgiveness and seek revenge.
    - a. We grow cold and shun the one we resent .... Or begin to gossip and slander them .... While pretending to maintain the relationship.
    - b. We destroy the relationship completely, never having anything to do with the person again.
    - c. We redefine what is sinful, making it unnecessary to forgive anything, sometimes fully and lovingly relating to the other person, but, more often, labeling them as different or alternative, but not sinful.
    - d. It's easy to forgive something that we don't regard as a serious offense.
  - 3. Verses 34-35 God looks upon our failure to forgive as a serious offense.
    - a. There are consequences and they are severe.
